



## Announcement of FALL 2009, Registration

For the thirty-second consecutive year, the Midlothian Youth Soccer League is offering soccer programs for boys and girls born from August 1, 1990 to July 31, 2006.

### VOLUNTEERS:

MYSL is a volunteer-run organization. We depend upon our volunteers to make our programs run smoothly. We are in particular need of people willing to serve as coaches or assistants. MYSL will provide necessary training to make this a fun and positive experience. It is incumbent on each family to assist the league by volunteering in some capacity each season. In the event that it is necessary to limit the number of teams due to lack of volunteers, spaces will be filled first by players whose parents volunteer in the league. PLEASE GET INVOLVED!!

Depending on availability of coaches and players, MYSL will organize divisions based on the following dates of birth:

- \*Coed programs are available to children born from August 1, 1990 thru July 31, 2005.
  - \*Girl's programs are available to children born from August 1, 1990 thru July 31, 2003.
  - \*Coed U04 program is available to children born from August 1, 2005 thru July 31, 2006.

Register before 6/30/09 to insure your child's placement on a team. You can REGISTER ON-LINE at [www.mysl.com](http://www.mysl.com) The league office is located at 13507 East Boundary Road, Suite G. You are encouraged to register on-line to avoid late registrations. Anyone desiring to play out of their age group, must make a request with necessary paperwork prior to June 15, 2009. \*SEE BELOW. Please call the league office at 744-8505 with questions.

Registrations must be received or postmarked on or before 6/30/09. Registrations received after 6/30/09 (with late fees of \$25 per player) are accepted on a space available basis for players.

**LOCATION OF PRACTICE AND SOME PLAY:** Midlothian Youth Soccer Park at Hensley off Winterpock Road and Beach Roads and Woodlake Complex. Some cross-association teams (U14 and older) may practice and play at other alternate locations.

### REGISTRATION FORMS:

Each player must submit a completed registration form, photocopy of player's birth certificate (if not on file with MYSL), and appropriate fee (including late fees if due). Incomplete registrations cannot be processed until all the information required has been received. You can register on-line beginning 5/1/09.

### FEES:

**For Coed U04 only:** \$70 fee to cover six one-hour sessions-Parent and child participate together. No uniform required. Players are not on a team at this age level. They participate as a group with trainers and participate in game type situations along with skills development. There is a cap of 60 players that we are able to accept for this age group. Sessions are held 3-4 p.m. on Saturdays.

**All others:** \$125 for first player in one family, \$215 for two players in one family and \$300 for three players in one family. (\$95 for first child, \$90 for second child, and \$85 for each additional player in family). *Each family is assessed a \$30 capital campaign fee per season, per family that is already included in the above registration fee of \$125 for one child) to go towards long term development.* There is a \$40 uniform charge for players needing a uniform. Replacement fees are noted on registration form. The \$25 late fee applies to each player!! There is an additional county imposed charge of \$10.00 for players NOT living in Chesterfield County. **SPECIAL REQUESTS:** WE ARE NOT ABLE TO HONOR Coaching OR Other Special Requests Due To The Large Number of Player Registrations We Receive And Possible Conflicts With Club Policy. ANY SPECIAL CONCERNS MUST BE IN WRITING AND ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION FORM ON A SEPARATE PIECE OF PAPER DUE BY 6/15/09. \*REQUESTS TO PLAY OUT OF YOUR AGE GROUP MUST INCLUDE HEIGHT AND WEIGHT AND ALSO INCLUDE AN EVALUATION SUPPORTING THIS REQUEST FROM YOUR CHILD'S PREVIOUS SEASON COACH AND ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION and be received by June 15 to allow for a proper approval process. You will be notified of a decision. If you previously played up, you still need to request to continue playing up. This must be processed manually.

### REFUND POLICY:

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN THE FOLLOWING:

1. Not being able to place a child on a team roster as a result of full divisions.
2. A lack of coaches.
3. Players medically unfit to play the first scheduled game (documented by physician's statement).

### POLICY:

# FALL 2009 Programs

## Recreational Programs

The FALL season has the first of nine games scheduled beginning Saturday, September 12, 2009 and ending Saturday, November 14, 2009 with no games scheduled on Saturday, October 10, 2009. Recreational Programs accommodate both beginning and advanced soccer players. All players will play at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  game. Our goal is to provide balanced team play. A \$40 uniform fee provides players with two shirts, 1 pair of shorts and 2 pairs of socks. The player provides shinguards, which are available locally at sporting goods stores. Wire rimmed glasses and earrings are not permitted on the pitch for safety reasons. *The player's date of birth governs team placement. Practices are usually held during the week and may start approximately two weeks prior to the first game of the season. Games are played on Saturdays.*

**Recreational Age Groupings** MYSL will use the age designation adopted by the United States Soccer Federation that governs state and local clubs.

**Coed U04** - a parent/child program, specifically designed to introduce parents and children to the game of soccer. Basic skills and small sided games for both parents and players will be offered to have fun and learn more about soccer. Coed U04 teams do not practice during the week. Six one-hour sessions will be offered at Hensley. Cost: \$70 for six one-hour sessions. 1<sup>st</sup> session will begin on or around Saturday, September 19, 2009. No uniform purchase required. There is a cap of 60 players that can participate in this age group. Children are not on teams at this age level.

**Coed U05** - is for our younger players and offers an introductory program to soccer players and their parents. Competition is not the emphasis and both parents and players will be encouraged to have fun and learn about soccer. Coed U05 will practice at least 1 time per week. All games will be played at the Midlothian Youth Soccer Park at Hensley.

**Coed U06, U07, U08, GU08, CU10, GU10, CU12 and GU12** - will play games at the Midlothian Youth Soccer Park at Hensley. Practices are usually held during the week and start approximately two weeks prior to the first game of the season. U8's and below do not play with goalkeepers.

**Coed U14, U16 and U19/Girls U14, U16 and U19** - participate in cross association play. Practices and most games will be played in Chesterfield County. Home games are now held at the Midlothian Youth Soccer Park at Hensley.

**Referee Certification** - is available to individuals interested in learning more about soccer and to gain knowledge and experience in refereeing soccer and an excellent way for coaches to learn more about the game. Please check out the website at [www.vadcsoccerref.com](http://www.vadcsoccerref.com) for up to date information on classes being held during the year. Pre-registration is required. After certification is received, please contact the MYSL to give us your availability for match assignments.

**Free Soccer Clinics are available to MYSL members throughout the year.** Various clinics are available without cost to MYSL members on a wide variety of soccer related subjects. In addition, MYSL has a soccer library for persons interested in VCR or soccer literature.
